2. Differentiate the following functions.

(a) (8 points)
$$f(x) = 6x^3 - \sqrt[5]{x} - \frac{4}{x^2} + \sin x$$

(b) (8 points)
$$g(x) = x^6 \tan x$$

(c) (8 points)
$$h(x) = \frac{x^6}{4 - 3x^5}$$

3. Differentiate the following functions.

(a) (8 points)
$$f(x) = \cos \sqrt{x^2 + 1}$$

(b) (8 points)
$$g(x) = \left(\frac{2x+1}{1-3x}\right)^8$$

(c) (8 points)
$$h(x) = \sec\left(\frac{1}{x}\right)$$

4. Consider the following implicit equation.

$$6x^3 + x^2y - xy^3 = 6 (\star)$$

(a) (8 points) Use implicit differentiation to find $\frac{dy}{dx}$.

(b) (8 points) Use your answer from part (a) to write an equation for the line tangent to the curve defined by equation (\star) at the point (2,3).

5. (8 points) Two cars start moving from the same point. One travels south at 40 mi/h and the other travels west at 30 mi/h. At what rate is the distance between the cars increasing two hours later?
