#### OVERVIEW

Each lecture will begin with an opportunity for students to ask questions. Please ask questions! You can ask about specific homework exercises or ask for a quick review of a topic that is not yet mastered, or anything at all. Then we will learn new material and apply it to solving problems. Homework exercises will be assigned and posted to johnadamski.com. Please make time to work on homework exercises every day. It is essential that you practice consistently, and ideally you will work through all assigned exercises before the next class. If you go more than two lectures without doing homework, you are falling behind (and this is a slippery slope!). Homework will not be collected or graded, but detailed solutions will be posted. You are expected to compare your solutions to mine, and to ask questions whenever anything is unclear.

Quizzes will be taken every Tuesday and will cover the previous week's material. The cumulative midterm exam will be on Tuesday 7/3/2018. Quiz and exam questions will be based on assigned exercises. Ocassionally, questions will be taken directly from the homework.
